☐ 1) The contributions are under one of the categories that the IJP accepts for publication.

2) The digital file that contains the contribution:

☐ has only the text with titles and abstracts in two languages;

☐ has no clues or suggestions to identify the authors;

☐ is in *Word* o *WordPerfect* and in an electronic form;

☐ is in *Times New Roman* 12 font and double space;

☐ contain no capital letters in titles;

☐ is formatted in for print in A4 or letter with margins of 1 inch;

☐ do not exceed thee number of pages and references (see Table I).

4) In the text exist:

☐ a title of around 12 words;

☐ three to five keywords;

☐ an abstract of around 150 words.

5) In Spanish if the text of the contribution is in English, or in English is the language is in any other language:

☐ a title of around 12 words;

☐ three to five keywords;

☐ an abstract of around 150 words..

☐ 6) All names of cities and geographical features are completed with a "/" followed by a two-letter acronym (ISO 3661) the country where they are located (no spaces before or after the "/").

7) References:

☐ cited the interamerican literature that pertains to the contribution including articles in the Interamerican Journal Psychology;

☐ reference citations followed the *American Psychological Association* manual (6th ed.);

☐ all references are listed in the text and in the reference list.

8) The language used:
