Purpose: This project will expand and enhance Johns Hopkins University's existing graduate-level initial certification programs at the secondary level. This is intended to improve the program that recruits, prepares, and supports Highly Qualified Teachers of secondary students with high-incidence disabilities that conform to Maryland's program approval requirements for certification and licensure.

Method: Project work involves: (a) enhancing the collaborative special education teacher preparation program focusing on secondary subject content areas; (b) enhancing recruitment of underrepresented culturally and linguistically diverse (CLD) candidates for application to teacher preparation programs, and promoting understanding of CLD students among teacher candidates; (c) expanding and enhancing systems of mentoring and support for program participants; and (d) designing alternative learning activities for nontraditional students to access and complete secondary content elements of the preparation program.
