ESOL

Students completing the certification program are required to complete ESOL training

If a 3-hour ESOL survey course has <u>no</u>t been completed OR documentation of completion of 60 hours of district in-service training is not submitted, students are required to complete TSL 6700.

If the requirement has been met, documentation must be attached to your Program Plan upon submission



Additional Information

LiveText:

LiveText is a program in which ratings are rendered for each student specific to the Florida Principal Leadership Standards associated with each course.

Every student in the program is required to establish a LiveText account during their first semester.

Students will receive an e-mail with instructions for establishing the account.



Additional Information

Florida Educational Leadership Examination (FELE):

Students enrolled in the Educational Leadership, a state-approved and NCATE (National Council for the Accreditation of Teacher Education) program, must provide passing scores for all pertinent sections of the FELE prior to graduation from the program. Documentation should be sent to the University of Florida (Institution Code: 5812) and to the department at least 60 days prior to the graduation date.
