Project Narrative

As a school of choice, UF Lab School has maintained enrollment/attendance of all students who accepted the invitation to enroll and attend P.K. Yonge Developmental Research School (as determined by random selection from the admissions application pool).

UF Lab School is currently projecting full enrollment for the 2021-2022 school year.

The funds set aside for this allocation will be used to maintain a part-time attendance clerk (.30 FTE) who will continue to assist the school in directly contacting students and families regarding attendance as we anticipate the possibility of covid-related, extended illness and/or quarantine through the 2021-2022 school year. The purpose of maintaining this part-time position is to track student attendance and improve learner engagement in distance education when a student is sick and/or in quarantine due to exposure to covid-19.

The designated attendance clerk personally contacts any family where student attendance or learning engagement may be lagging via email and phone call. Additionally, the attendance clerk is bilingual and easily communicates with our Spanish-speaking families, thereby greatly enhancing attendance and learning engagement with our Hispanic/Latino families.
