

ESSER II Lump Sum Narrative

UF Lab School

UF Lab School has identified 6 priorities for the ESSER II Lump Sum allocation:

- 1) **Extend School Nurse Appointment to Full-Time for 2021-22 SY:** .15 FTE plus fringe/benefits to increase the school nurse appointment from .85 FTE to 1.0 FTE for the purpose of coordinating P.K. Yonge's Covid response when needed with UF Health, Department of Health, families, students, faculty, staff, and administrators.

- 2) **1.0 FTE Instructional Technology Coach/Coordinator for 2021-22 SY:** Maintain the 2020-2021 CARES-funded position to support on-demand course access for students who may be withheld from face-to-face classes for an extended absence due to Covid. The IT coach/coordinator works with faculty to design, develop, and deliver Canvas courses.

- 3) **Summer 2022 Instructional Technology Coach/Coordinator:** Employ the Instructional Technology Coach/Coordinator for four weeks of 1.0 FTE summer 2022 to prepare and support individual student devices for the K-12 summer intervention/credit recovery program to mitigate learning loss.

- 4) **Chromebooks:** Purchase replacement Chromebooks for failing, school-issued, student devices to support continuity of student learning on/off campus through the school year as student learning and access to learning is impacted by Covid.

- 5) **Purchase Choral Masks/Bell Covers:** Purchase uniquely designed facial masks for choral students to provide to students who elect to wear a facial covering during choral classes. Purchase bell covers for the band program to mitigate the potential spread of Covid.

- 6) **Part-time Middle School Math Tutor:** For the 2021-2022 school year, a math tutor will provide personalized, intensive instruction for middle school students falling behind in mathematics due to the impact of Covid on student learning loss.
