Scope of Work

Dr. Splett will provide guidance and leadership for ISF implementation and model revisions during all phases of the proposed project. Her expertise implementing and evaluating the ISF will be leveraged to inform preparation for model implementation, the pilot phase and iterative model improvement, and two-year model demonstration activities. Dr. Splett will also lend her expertise in universal screening to support quality administration and use of screening data in the ISF model, and in leading administration and action planning with the measure of ISF fidelity and interagency coordination, ISF Implementation Inventory (ISF-II). Dr. Splett will oversee collection of cost data and related analyses drawing from her cost-effectiveness experience on a recent randomized controlled trial of the ISF. Dr. Splett will co-lead and attend weekly project team meetings via telephone conference, and attend on-site meetings at project schools, with district and community leaders, and with project officer(s) in person as needed. Dr. Splett will also co-lead and assist with the development of project reports, publications and dissemination activities, and will assure communication with national leaders as to the study's progress and outcomes.
