

We are proposing a 2-day conference called “An Interdisciplinary Convening on Using Intersectionality Theory in Quantitative Research: Seeking Shared Expectations on Review and Publishing Standards” (Hereafter referred to as “The Convening”). The Convening will bring together authors, reviewers, and editors whose work has involved quantitative research methods and intersectionality theory. Following a Delphi approach, the investigators will prepare for the conference by administering surveys to invited attendees to learn why some manuscripts fall short in trying to advance their respective fields by using quantitative methods for intersectionality research. After collecting survey data, the purpose of The Convening will be to facilitate conversation and work toward developing shared expectations about how to conduct, communicate, review, and publish intersectionality research using quantitative methods. At the end of The Convening, we will create online resources to aid authors, reviewers, and editors (which may also serve as teaching tools for faculty instructors and advisers) to help implement conference solutions in to practice. The proposed project dates re July 1, 2022 – December 21, 2023.
