

## **Scope of Work**

ECPIHE Fellowships Proposal

The University of Florida's Early Childhood Policy Centers Collaborative (ECP-CC) will provide financial stipends to graduate student enrollees in UF's early childhood policy graduate certificate and master's degree program. As described in the proposal narrative, we will support 5-6 students per year across the certificate and master's with stipends ranging from approximately half to the full cost of their program. We will also provide funding for a select set of fellows to travel to DC for a national convening in year 2.

The stipends for fellows will be coordinated by F. Chris Curran (PI), Patricia Snyder (co-PI), and Katy Chapman (co-PI). This includes the selection of fellows and distribution of stipends. During year 2, some of the faculty will also join the fellows for the national convening in DC. Collaborating faculty and College of Education staff who work with the graduate certificate and master's degree will assist with logistical aspects of stipend disbursement as needed.

Students receiving stipends will receive advising, mentorship, and engagement in wraparound events as part of their typical progression in their respective programs.
