Justin Ortagus, Ph.D., will serve as the Principal Investigator (PI) and point of contact for the project. He will be responsible for overseeing the project through all stages of the process and for supervising project personnel. PI Ortagus will serve as project lead for the ROI report, control all financial aspects of the research grant, and ensure compliance with all protocols. He will also ensure the successful completion of all aspects of the proposed deliverables, including a policy brief, two research papers, and publicly available dataset (expedited and created to focus solely on PBF policies). PI Ortagus will monitor project deliverables and ensure milestones and timelines are met at each phase of the project.

Graduate Research Assistant (GRA) will provide support for all activities of the project, but the GRA will focus specifically on working with the PI and Co-PIs to complete PBF data cleaning activities and produce annotated bibliographies to aid in the production of the final deliverables.

Postdoctoral Associate (Year 2) will provide support for all Year 2 deliverables, including data cleaning in preparation of data release, preliminary analyses using our novel dataset, policy brief, and research papers.
