Title 1, Part A: To provide students a fair, equitable, and high-quality education and to close educational achievement gaps.

As a single-school public school district, PK Yonge Developmental Research School (DRS) is committed to systems design and implementation that supports the academic needs of all students. Title 1 funds support mathematics programs for 4th-8th graders, aiming for all students to demonstrate Algebra 1 proficiency by high school. Mathematics often presents challenges, with students developing fixed mindsets about their abilities. PK Yonge addresses this through targeted programs that remove barriers to math learning and help students meet Florida's academic standards.

PK Yonge has transitioned to a standards or mastery-based grading and reporting system in each mathematics classroom, which has provided for a more targeted, systematic approach to review student data for subsequent intervention planning to support students. The synchronization of student services, teacher learning, and summer learning opportunities in mathematics are supported through program and curricular design, to streamline funding and services for students and teachers.
