

Agreement for Admission to the Doctor of Education Program (Ed.D.) in Curriculum and Instruction, Specializing in Educational Technology

1. General Agreement

This agreement applies to doctoral applicants seeking admission to the Ed.D. program in Curriculum and Instruction with a concentration in Educational Technology. The objectives of this agreement are to ensure understanding of admissions policies and program structure.

2. This agreement is entered into between the Educational Technology faculty of the School of Teaching and Learning and

3. Term

This agreement pertains to the application for admission to the Ed.D. program in Curriculum and Instruction (concentration in Educational Technology) scheduled to commence in the Fall semester, 2022.

4. Admission Policies

The applicant understands that:

- This program accepts applications for the cohort beginning in the Fall semester 2022 after the applicants completes all prerequisite requirements, including a Master's degree in Education, Educational Technology or a related field.
- A phone interview with program faculty will be required in the application process
- Admitted students will begin their program provided that the necessary number of students apply and are admitted for the cohort.

5. Program Structure

The applicant understands that:

- This program is scheduled as a cohort program with a specified sequence of courses. Applicants who are unable to continue with their initial cohort must join a later cohort.
- Regular and meaningful contribution to the program's virtual community is expected.
- All cohort members meet face-to-face on the UF campus annually. The Fall 2022 cohort will meet for 2 days (**on August 27th and 28th, 2022**) at the University of Florida's College of Education. This meeting is the only campus-based requirement for 2022.

•Future campus-based experiences will occur in **June 2023** for 4 days and **May 2024** for 3 days in length. Dates will be communicated at the previous on-campus meeting (e.g. in 2022 for 2023) to allow participants to plan. The campus-based experience is an annual requirement of the program.

•Students are required to attend their dissertation defense meeting in person, it will be scheduled at the convenience of the student and the committee.

•Applicants are responsible for travel expenses, lodging and meals during the campus-based experiences.
