Goal	Progress
Align <i>Professional Leave Committee</i> language with CBA	<i>Professional Development Leave and Sabbatical Committee</i> language approved by FPC and posted on COE policies page
Consider NTTF representation on T&P committee	COE Constitutional language (as of 4.27.22) specifies that tenured faculty serve on the T&P committee. Would need to modify Constitution for NTTF to serve.
Continue conversation about a possible COE-wide policy about joint appointments	Presented draft language to FPC at the January meeting. FPC to send language out for public comment.
Review CBA and COE constitution alignment	Reviewed the work from last year's committee and did not see alignment issues
Review BAC related to merit policies	Identified two areas FPC might want to consider (1) a perceived lack of transparency in the process and (2) possible lack of equal treatment in terms of productivity. Unsure if any FPC actions have been taken.
Align a Progress-to-Promotion for Non-Tenure Faculty to CBA	Revised Pre-Promotion Review policy to align with CBA. Next year's group should revisit and take through the FPC process.
