Deans' & College Level Reports

- Associate Dean Thomasenia Adams
 - o External funding for Feb 2024: three awards (appox. \$427K total), 17 proposals submitted
 - o UF Libraries will provide a presentation, tomorrow (March 19th) at 12pm
 - o March 26th at 12 pm Rosabel and I will be host a session on all things pre and post awards for all PIs. A great opportunity to get updates.
 - O University is hosting several sessions for faculty for tenure and promotion (T/P), very helpful to receive information about changes at the University. Two sessions will be held:
 - April 9th:9:30-11:30am, Room LG-101A DeWeese Conf Room, McKnight Brain Institute
 - April 11th: 9:30-11:30am, Reitz Union Chamber Room
 - We have 15 candidates for the next T/P cycle for 2024-25: 5 candidates from PKY, 10 candidates from COE; 17 candidates currently under review
 - o Post Tenure Review (PTR)
 - The university has asked that we as administrators withhold in engaging in conversation on PTR until bargaining has been finalized.
 - OER is designed to serve the faculty. We are always here to support your research and scholarship efforts.

- Associate Dean Erica McCray
 - o Searches continue, we are close to wrapping up
 - 12 new faculty have already signed letters of offer
 - 2 additional searches continuing in school psychology and higher education
 - Hoping to wrap those up within the next 2 weeks
 - o Faculty affairs side, Associate Provost Dr. Chris Hass has sent a message asking all faculty (if you haven't already) to create a work ID (open research and contributor ID)
 - You can visit orcid.org to create one if you haven't done so yet
 - o International center continues to offer PD opportunities, please take advantage of those
 - They are currently offering PD on virtual exchange
- Interim Associate Dean Elayne Colon
 - No updates
- Dean Glenn Good
 - CAEP accreditation review occurring now, faculty candidate interviews and associated hiring keeping things busy, and lots of college activities are happening.
 - The IT department is going to be short-staffed; they are doing the best they can as they search for more people to fill positions. Please be understanding and reduce elective IT requests.
 - Upon initial analysis, enrollment seems lower compared to last year. We have not confirmed the final analysis. Please maximize course enrollment as best as possible as our fiscal well-being depends on health enrollments.
 - Associate Dean Thomasenia Adams will be leading the search for the next Director of the School of Human Development & Organizational Studies in Education (HDOSE). This search will be posted soon.
 - o Initial signs indicate that the COE's *US News and World Reports* ranking will continue its decade long positive trend.
