I have also used technology as a way of communicating with my parents. On our class website I have included important information for parents to access. I have links to educational websites as well as school related sites. This year I have even used our website to show off students work. My parents love being able to see their child's work. As a safety factor I do not include my student's pictures or names. I think the use of a class website can enhance our student's education as well as our parent's education. I know my parents love being able to see their child's work published.

As a teacher I have taken classes to find effective ways to enhance my teaching with the use of technology. The classes show teachers how to include computers into everyday lessons. We have learned how to use a variety of programs that are available to anyone with a computer. I am now able to create movies in my class on a variety of topics. Next year, I would like to create a movie with my class to show parents at open house.

As a teacher I have realized how important technology is to our student's future. In order for our students to become successful adults, we need to show them how to use technology as an educational tool, not as a form of entertainment. I think additional technology training should be offered to all educators.
