

Instructional Leadership and Faculty Development Grant

P.K. Yonge seeks to address four critical areas of leadership development through the design and implementation of the Instructional Leadership and Faculty Development Grant. Four broad areas for leadership development addressed include: internal accountability, individual and collective agency, technical and social/emotional dimensions of improvement, and leveraging the system of distributed leadership that exists at P.K. Yonge.

The scope of work outlined in the project seeks to build internal accountability through the development of individuals' understanding of what they are responsible for and how they will be held responsible through practice, a focus on developing and modeling common values in the work of instructional practice, and an emphasis on both individual and collective agency directly related to instructional practice among all stakeholders. Instructional leadership continues to demonstrate these connections through a close and collaborative examination of practice.
