Institute for Child Success Project

The purpose of this project is to conduct a survey of child care providers in South Carolina to elicit information regarding suspension and expulsion practices. The primary activities associated with this project will be the following: (a) a review of recent research relating to suspension and expulsion practices of early care and education providers; (b) development and deployment of a survey to be completed by early care and education providers in South Carolina wherein they report on the practices they use to support children with challenging behavior; and (c) an analysis of the data generated through the survey and a report of findings.
