As the leader of this project, Dr. Curran will continue to commit time to the publication and presentation of articles from this work, the archiving of data, and the development of dissemination materials. During the subaward period, Dr. Curran will complete one trip to present at the annual meeting of the American Society of Criminology as well as several trips to present findings of the work to researchers at other universities. In addition, Dr. Curran will lead the dissemination of work to practitioners through the production of a series of printed research briefs and short videos. These briefs will reach school district leadership and law enforcement agency leadership, thereby widening the scope of practitioners that are aware of the research and furthering the National Institute of Justice's interest in widespread dissemination of this work. Dr. Curran will continue to work on developing manuscripts and furthering these manuscripts through the review and publication process during the time period of the subaward.
