

## **Building Leadership for Change Through School Immersion: Cohort 3.2**

The University of Florida (UF) will provide the faculty, staff, curriculum, course textbooks, educational facilities, immersion sites, and schools for the Building Leadership for Change Through School Immersion: Cohort 3.2 program. The university is offering the program for continuing education purposes only and not as part of a degree program. Therefore, participants are not admitted to the university, are not considered to be university students for any purpose and will not receive university credit for participating in or completing the program.

Nevertheless, the university agrees to provide the necessary documents and services that participants need to obtain and maintain the required immigration legal status. The university will design and implement all five phases of the program as applicable for each participant, which will be administered during the term.

The participants in the program will be non-English language teachers, counselors, English language teachers, and principals selected by the Saudi Arabian Cultural Mission (SACM). Participants and their family members are responsible for, at their sole costs and expense, obtaining proper and timely authorization from the United States immigration services to enter the United States to participate in the program. The university will provide orientation to the participants immediately upon their arrival. Such orientation will include, but not be limited to, informing participants of the following: (i) the new environment, (ii) UF's grounds and facilities, (iii) any safety and security measure the participant should be aware of, (iv) rules and regulations about the preservation of property, (v) U.S. community laws, (vi) the description and caring of UF grounds, (vii) the usage of the library and other facilities, (viii) UF rules and regulations; (ix) any orientation of which a participant should be aware as an international student; (x) detailed information about immigration laws/rules while the participant and any family members of the participant are residing in the U.S. for the duration of the program.
