

**Positive Behavioral Interventions and Support:
Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (PBIS–MTSS)**

UF faculty staff and students who are collaborating on PBIS activities will do the following:

1. Provide technical assistance, training, ongoing professional development and support to five North Central Florida school districts including Levy County, Gilchrist County, Alachua County, and/or other counties as assigned).
2. Participate in monthly staff meetings on-site or remotely through phone and/or web-based platforms.
3. Participate in monthly staff live chats on topics related to project activities.
4. Host project live chats and other webinars related to topics of interest for districts and school-based faculty and staff as needed/assigned.
5. Meet on an as needed basis with project staff.
6. Provide technical assistance to Levy, Alachua, and Gilchrist counties (and/or other counties as assigned) schools by means of the identified PBIS District Coordinator following the protocol provided by the FLPBIS Project.
7. Participate in Classroom Coaching Guide workgroup activities as scheduled and/or any other workgroup activities (e.g., rural school professional development and support) as designated by FLPBIS Project directors.
8. Participate in the development, review, and revision/update of project related materials and resources (e.g., Tier 2 training material revision) as needed/assigned.
9. Submit or co-submit conference proposals to regional, national, and international conferences focused on project work.
10. Present or co-present at regional, national, and international conferences focused on project work.
11. Attend additional trainings as needed/required to either a) develop trainer skill sets or to b) assist other project staff in conducting trainings and/or to help develop skill sets.
12. Assist in writing and/or write scholarly publications for peer review related to project activities on an as needed/appropriate basis.
