## **Charleston Comprehensive Literacy Initiative Summer Camp 2020**

Teachers will gain an understanding of the reading process and the skills necessary to teach reading separate from specific programs, thus improving reading instructional practice, implementing programs with fidelity, making data-based instructional decisions, and in turn setting more students on an early path to literacy and future academic achievement. In addition, teachers will gain knowledge and skills on how to apply teaching strategies in an online setting. The summer camp is tailored to provide teachers with knowledge and skills to provide evidence-based literacy instruction to meet the needs of struggling students.

Professional Development sessions include the following:

- Instruction in using the Flamingo Learning Virtual Reading App
- Job-embedded coaching via Zoom

After engaging in this professional development, participants will

- 1. Be able to support learners in encoding and decoding words;
- 2. Be able to conduct a running record to determine accuracy and determine student strengths and needs;
- 3. Be able to support learners in connecting oral and written language;
- 4. Be able to support students in acquiring strategies to read texts;
- 5. Be able to support learners in generalizing reading strategies to a variety of text genres.
