Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Fund under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, Career Tech Programs

Entrepreneurship (8812100): Beginning 2020-2021 P.K. Yonge will begin offering the three course sequence associated with this CTE program (Principles of Entrepreneurship; Business Management; and Business Ownership). Projected enrollment is 25 - 30 students for 2020-2021 and is expected to increase by 100% or more over the next three school years. Computers and equipment purchased with this grant will be used to support the launch of this CTE option during the 2020-2021 school year. Purchases include a complete screen printing shop, iPads/cases/styluses, Macbook PRos, a Dremel Laster Cutter with filtration, and a Dremel 3D printer.

Engineering Pathways (9400300): Enrollment in this CTE program to extend our middle school Project Lead The Way course offerings to high school began in 2019-2020 with an enrollment of 21 students and is projected to increase to 100 for the 2020-2021 school year. Costs associated with introducing new PLTW course options for our high school students seeking to complete this CTE program will be supported by this grant. Purchases requests include 3 sets of Dremel filament, Vex robotics kits, PLTW curriculum access for the four high school courses (Intro to Engineering; Digital Electronics; Principles of Engineering; Engineering Design and Development), two Work Benches, and a Dremel Laser Cutter with filtration.
