

## **Preschool Development Grant – Birth through Five Renewal Child Care Resource and Referral**

This contract supports Florida's grant award from the state's application to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Administration of Children and Families (ACF) Preschool Development Grant – Birth through Five Renewal (PDG-R).

The purpose of this contract is to engage the University of Florida to provide the following:

- Host within its learning management system (LMS) five web-based Child Care Resource and Referral (CCR&R) training modules, a specialist certification exam, and pilot the training and certification exam to 50 Office of Early Learning (OEL)-designated CCR&R and referral agency specialists from diverse agencies. The CCR&R is a free service for any family living in or preparing to move to Florida which helps families identify and select quality child care and early education programs and offers consumer education and community resources.
- Collect both qualitative and quantitative data in order to provide a report that informs OEL of improvements needed to the training modules or certification exam prior to statewide implementation.
- Following any needed revision from the pilot, host the final OEL-approved CCR&R training modules and certification exam on the University of Florida's LMS and make available to OEL-designated users.
