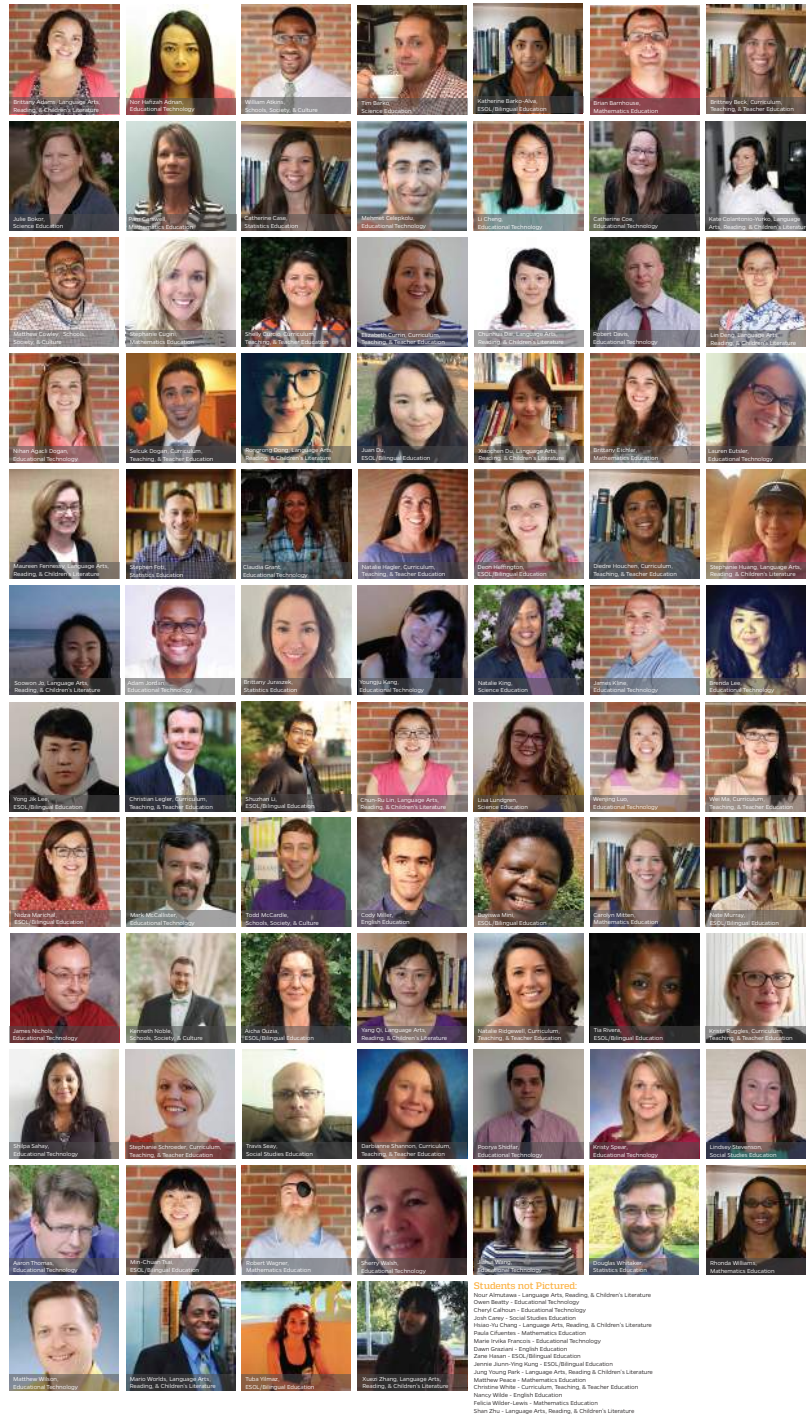
### Students as Colleagues
