## EEX 7787: School Improvement for All Students

### Purpose Of The Course:

This doctoral seminar addresses the problems that currently exist within the educational system in delivering effective, well-integrated instruction to students who experience difficulty progressing academically or adjusting socially in school. The specific purposes of this course are to provide participants with information regarding the following:

- A) The current status of problems facing students who experience difficulty progressing academically and socially in public schools;
- B) Approaches to school improvement that may be used to provide more effective and efficient inclusive school experiences for all students;
- C) Barriers that may impede the school change which is needed to ensure the delivery of effective, well-integrated (e.g., inclusive) services to these students;
- D) Strategies that may be used to improve teacher practices; and
- E) Strategies that may be used to facilitate school change.
