Please join UF's Education College Council and College of Education, in partnership with the River Phoenix Center for Peace Building, Peace4Gainesville, Alachua County Public Schools, PACE Center for Girls, UF's Center for the Study of Race and Race Relations, Center on Children and Families, and the Florida Society for the Social Sciences, for a screening of the James Redford film *Paper Tigers*. A pizza dinner will be offered before the film and a panel discussion on how to build a trauma responsive community in Gainesville will follow.

Paper Tigers follows a year in the life of an alternative high school that has radically changed its approach to disciplining its students, becoming a promising model for how to break the cycles of poverty, violence, and disease that affect families. *This film is not rated. However, it does contain sensitive, unedited language and mentions topics such as sexual molestation, violence, and suicide.
