The 2016 Florida Undergraduate Research Conference will be held in the heart of downtown Tampa at the campus of The University of Tampa, Feb. 26-27, 2016.

The Florida Undergraduate Research Conference (FURC) is one of the nation's largest multi-disciplinary research conferences. It is an annual event open to all undergraduate researchers in the state of Florida to present their research in a poster forum. Every year the conference is hosted at a different university in the state on the last weekend in February. In addition to research presentations, there are also exhibitors from graduate programs and other opportunities targeted for students involved in undergraduate research.

UT's 105-acre residential and modern campus – which features Plant Hall, a National Historic Landmark built in 1891 – provides an ideal site for FURC 2016 and is within walking distance from many of Tampa's downtown activities.
