**Position Description:**

Seeking energetic graduate student to join the STRIVE (Sexual Trauma/ Interpersonal Violence Education) at GatorWell team. Students of all gender identities are encouraged to apply. STRIVE educates, inspires and empowers UF students to actively participate in creating a campus community that is free from interpersonal violence. Primary responsibilities will include facilitating educational activities and discussions with student groups, delivering presentations on interpersonal violence and related topics, training, supervising, and mentoring undergraduate peer educators, and working collaboratively to organize awareness-raising events. Lead Peer Educators are expected to take a leadership role in planning and executing these events. They will work closely with the GatorWell Interpersonal Violence Prevention Coordinator to guide the direction of STRIVE's efforts. This is a great opportunity for a student who wants to get hands-on teaching and leadership experience while making a difference in the campus community! **Time Commitment:**

- Times needed vary week to week. May be hired at 11 hours, 14 hours, or 20 hours per week, depending on availability.
- Must have a mixture of day and evening availability. Must be able to commit to on average 1 to 2 evenings per week. Availability must include Tuesday through Thursday 10 am-2 pm for tabling and outreach, Monday through Thursday evenings 5-9 pm for presentations and outreach, Fridays 9 pm -12 am for Gator Nights, and some weekend work.
- Must be able to attend weekly team meetings.
- Must be able to attend the August GatorWell Student Employee Orientation Training prior to the start of fall semester activities (August 20 and 21).
- Must be able to attend Student Affairs Graduate Student training prior to the start of fall semester. Date to be determined; one weekday in late August.
