PURPOSE OF STUDY:

- Students may have a formal diagnosis of dyslexia but do not need to have a diagnosis of dyslexia. We will test for dyslexia.

STUDY INFORMATION:

- Participation will take 1-2 hours
- Participants will wear an electroencephalography (EEG) headset that records brain activity during part of the study
- Non-UF students will not be expected to travel to UF; researchers from the College of Education at the University of Florida will travel to the participants' home institution at a mutually convenient time.
