

## OAK HALL SUMMER PROGRAM

The Oak Hall Summer Program is pleased to announce that it will hold a group interview day for summer camp positions listed below. A confirmation letter with instructions for the group interview to be held on February 18, 2017 will be sent following receipt of your resume and application. Attendance at the group interview is mandatory for consideration of employment and no exceptions will be made.

- Summer Day Camp Counselor in several specialty areas listed below. Counselor will be responsible for a group of approximately 8 kids (ages 5-12) daily and the management of 4 daily activity classes. Hours would be 8:30-4:15 three times weekly, 7:30-4:15 one day weekly, and 8:30-6:00 one day weekly. Salary is \$10.50/hour and we are looking for people with expertise in arts & crafts, outdoor education, aquatics (with required certifications-CPR/FA, AED, Lifeguard, and preference given to those with WSI Certification), indoor & outdoor sports, enrichment, and technology.
- Summer Day Camp Counselor responsible for a group of approximately 8 kids (ages 3-5) daily and the delivery of camp program. Hours would be 8:00-4:00 or 7:30-12:00. Salary is \$10.50/hour.
- Summer Day Camp Counselor in our Middle School Day Camp for kids entering grades 5-8. This is a daily travel camp which requires employee to have a strong swimming ability and a love of the outdoors. Counselor would assist director in the daily delivery of the program. Hours would be 8:30-4:00 and occasionally extended hours including overnights are required. Salary is \$10.50/hour and we are seeking one person for this position.
- Summer Day Camp Aftercare Counselor. Hours would be 4:00-6:00 daily. Salary is \$10.50/hour.
- Enrichment Program Director. Hours would be 7:30-4:00 daily. Responsibilities include provide programming for kids 10 & up in weekly half day camps including Lego Engineering, Extreme Survival Camp, Cupcake Wars, Myth Crushers, Dessert Wars, Escape the Room, and The Body Shop (making homemade lotions, etc.). Program Director would also be charged with morning care, lunch supervision, and assisting with programming during afternoon for extended care campers. Salary is \$12.50/hour and we are seeking one person for this position.

The Oak Hall Summer Program is also accepting applications for several half-day specialty camps. Attendance at group interview is not required and a personal interview will be scheduled with qualified candidates. Each camp below meets daily during the week listed from 8:30-12:45 p.m., unless otherwise noted. Salaries are dependent on enrollment and start at a minimum of \$450 for the 17.5 hour weekly commitment. The salary increases with each camper after 6 to be enrolled.
