Presentation Overview:



Over the past few years, we have heard a great deal about what is not happening in schools today. My research traveling to schools in the US and in other countries and interviews with dozens of teachers, school leaders, and others, has shown an incredible blending of changing pedagogical perspectives with new technologies. Two major outcomes will be discussed. First, there is an evolution in recognizing that all educators are not going to implement changing practice in the same way; thus, professional expectations must be personalized in the same way we strive to personalize student learning. Second, it is clear that school leaders are essential in the implementation of these changes, through their allocation of resources and in their celebration of individual's efforts. This talk brings together some of the exciting things that are happening in schools.

Lynne Schrum, Ph.D. is a Professor in the Abraham S. Fischler College of Education at Nova Southeastern University. Previously she served as Dean of the College of Education and Human Services, West Virginia University. Her research and teaching focus on appropriate uses of information technology, preparing school leaders and teachers for the 21st century, and effective and successful online teaching and learning. She has written and edited sixteen books and numerous articles; she has been the editor of the *Journal of Research on Technology in Education (JRTE)* (2002-2012; 2016-2018). Dr. Schrum is also a past-president of the International Society for Technology in Education (ISTE).
