Application/Nomination Items:

- Nominations will be open to all COE graduate students who have been enrolled for the past two of the last three terms (Summer 2017, Fall 2017, Spring 2018) at the UF College of Education
- No self-nominations will be accepted
- Letters of nomination must originate with a faculty member affiliated with the COE
- The applicant/nominee's resume must be included with the application/nomination
- Faculty should submit a one-page letter of nomination, including the title of the award, that pertains to the criteria below
- A maximum of two additional letters of support (one page each) will be accepted and may come from COE or other UF faculty

Criteria:

A maximum total of 30 points will be accrued, based on:

- ❖ (1-15 Points) for evidence of professional preparation and readiness, based on pedagogy, best practices, assessment and other skills linked to professional preparation.
- ❖ (1-10 Points) for scholarship, based on GPA
- ❖ (1-5 Points) evidence of service and leadership to the college, the university and the community, (i.e., participation, membership, and leadership in community activities, collegiate clubs, societies, etc.)
