Positions open:

- Math and Spanish

Responsibilities:

- Teach classes to high school participants as part of Santa Fe College Upward Bound Summer Program
- Selecting materials for designed course based on UB staff recommendations
- Developing and submitting an assessment plan
- Written evaluations of each student at the end of the summer program
- Chaperone field trips

Minimum Qualifications:

- Secondary or elementary teaching license, or graduate work on content areas
- Math: Ability to teach Geometry, Algebra 2, Pre-Calculus or Calculus
- Spanish: Knowledge and ability to teach the Spanish language to English speaking learners
- Motivation to work with students from diverse backgrounds

Preferred Qualifications:

- Graduate work in content area, previous teaching experience, or writing curriculum

- Teach three 50-minute classes
- Hourly rate of pay \$16.65
