Minimum Requirements for AA Transfer Admission

GPA: 2.6 AA GPA (3.0 Preferred)

Required Preprofessional Course (Grade of B or higher):
EDF 1005 Introduction to Education

Recommended Preprofessional Courses:
EDF2085 Teaching Diverse Populations*
EME 2040 Intro to Educational Technology

College Distribution Course – recommend take before transfer:
DEP2004 Human Growth and Development (or equivalent)

SAT or ACT Scores (can be earned after high school):
1010 SAT (Critical Reading + Math; no score below 440)
or 21 ACT

FTCE Scores: General Knowledge Test – pass all 4 subtests

Your application won't be considered without passing FTCE-GK scores. Plan to sit for the FTCE-GK by early January for fall transfer or early July for spring transfer. See www.fl.nesinc.com to register. Plan to apply for transfer admission around the same time (there is space to report courses in progress and any intended future courses you will take). See www.admissions.ufl.edu to apply.

Check in with your AA advisor to assure that all AA requirements will be met. See <http://admissions.ufl.edu/ugrad/trqualifying.html> for a checklist of University requirements all transfer applicants must meet.
